Ogio is committed to providing safe, superior quality products to consumers. To that end, Ogio has developed a robust compliance program designed to provide products that meet or exceed global regulatory requirements, including specific United States requirements such as the Consumer Product Safety Act (CPSA), the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act of 2008 (CPSIA), and the California Proposition 65, and specific European Union requirements such as REACH.

Prior to August 2018, Ogio products were labelled with a Proposition 65 warning based on a good faith analysis of the information then available. Currently, new product models and new production of existing products are tested to determine that Ogio products meet the restricted substance requirements published by the American Apparel and Footwear Association, which mirrors state and federal requirements. The AAFA restricted substance list can be found at [www.wewear.org](http://www.wewear.org). Thus, Ogio products meet California Proposition 65 requirements.

Ogio takes great care to ensure that the materials used in Ogio products are safe and meet all applicable laws and regulations. Ogio totes and bags sold by SanMar are general use products and are not specifically designed for use by children aged 12 and under.
